**Preparation:**

- Come ready to move. Female identified dancers should be in character shoes, male identified dancers in jazz shoes.
- In case you are asked to stay and sing, prepare one 16-bar cut of a song in the style the show. Bring sheet music in your key with your cut. An accompanist will be provided.
- Everyone must bring a current headshot and resume.

**Character Breakdowns:**

- **CELIE** (Female Identified Principal) – A Woman from Georgia whose story begins when she is 14. A survivor of abuse. Vulnerable, spirited, introverted, mischievous, has a sense of humor which is sometimes wicked. She is an observer. Eventually finds self-love and independence.
- **NETTIE** (Female Identified Principal) – Celie's younger sister. Adventurous, feisty, educated. She has a powerful bond with Celie. Forced by Mister to leave Celie, she starts a new life in Africa.

- **MISTER** (Male Identified Principal) – Local farm owner who becomes Celie's husband. Strong presence, dominating, capable of brutal behavior but also a victim. Gets his power for free. Married to Celie, he abuses her. He is in love with Shug. Eventually sees the error of his ways.
- **HARPO** (Male Identified Principal) – Mister's son from his first marriage. Vulnerable, confused, good-hearted son. Represents the new generation.
- **SOFIA** (Female Identified – ROLE CAST. SEEKING ENSEMBLE U/S.) – Harpo's wife. Powerful, physically strong and imposing woman. Comfortable in her skin, great sense of humor. She does not let anyone mistreat her.
- **SHUG AVERY** (Female Identified Principal) – Mister's long-time love, a singer who lives in Memphis. Powerful in her sexuality, dynamic, magnetic, irresistible, has a surprising frailty and vulnerability.
- **FEMALE ENSEMBLE/SQUEAK** (Female Identified Principal) – Harpo's lover after Sofia leaves him. Young, sassy, fiery, strong-willed, unafraid to take anybody on, has a caring heart.
- **FEMALE ENSEMBLE/CHURCH LADY** (Female Identified)

- **MALE ENSEMBLE/GUARD** (Male Identified)
